

POWER BOAT COURSES



There are a number of Power Boat courses available at Killary and you can work from an Introductory course right through to Safety Boat Driver. In all cases, the courses will only go ahead if there is a minimum of 3 booked. The courses will take place at Killary Adventure Co Leenane.

INTRODUCTION COURSE : €130, lunch + €9

Introduction to Powerboating - This course provides a practical introduction to powerboats and is ideal for anyone who is new to powerboating or who will be crewing a powerboat. This is a one day course and prepares a total beginner for the following course which is the 'National Powerboat Certificate'.

Course Type:	Personal Level
Craft Type:	Powerboat
Course Skill:	Beginner
Assumed Knowledge:	No previous knowledge required
Description:	This course provides a practical introduction to powerboats and is ideal for anyone who is new to powerboating or who will be crewing a powerboat.
Content:	You will be practicing all of the skills you need to become a useful and safe crew including helming, high speed manoeuvring, ropework.
Ability After Course:	You will be able to safely and effectively crew a powerboat and take the helm while under supervision.
Duration:	1 Day
Minimum Age	18

NATIONAL POWERBOAT CERTIFICATE : €260, + €60 residential in dorms

(2 day course + 2 nights B&B, 2 lunch, 1 dinner)

National Powerboat Certificate - As ISA call it this is the "driving licence" of powerboating. This course provides all of the skills and knowledge required by anyone taking charge of a powerboat..



Course Type:	Personal Level
Craft Type:	Powerboat
Course Skill:	Intermediate
Assumed Knowledge:	Skills & knowledge included in "An Introduction to Powerboating". However this course may be extended in duration to include these where participants have no previous experience.
Description:	The "driving licence" of powerboating. This course provides all of the skills and knowledge required by anyone taking charge of a powerboat.
Content:	Boat preparation, launch & recovery, low & high speed manoeuvres, anchoring & docking, basic navigation, weather & coastal knowledge, safety.
Ability After Course:	You will be competent to take charge of an open powerboat by day on inland and coastal waters with which you are familiar.
Duration:	2 Days
Minimum Age:	18

POWERBOATING EXPERIENCE COURSE: €260.00, + €60.00 residential in dorms

(2 day course + 2 nights B&B, 2 lunch, 1 dinner)

Powerboating experience course - ...is for those who need to log hours for the Safety Boat Course.

Course Type:	Personal Level
Craft Type:	Powerboat
Course Skill:	Intermediate
Assumed Knowledge:	Skills & knowledge included in ISA National Powerboat Certificate or equivalent.
Description:	Developed for powerboaters with some experience who want to boost their skills, knowledge and confidence. This course will show you how to enjoy family daytrips, longer coastal passages and sports activities like water skiing.
Content:	Boat Handling, mooring and anchoring, landing on beaches, swimming from a boat, angling, navigation & passage making.
Ability After Course:	You will be able to use your powerboat to its full potential participating in a range of activities close to and further from base.
Duration:	2 Days
Minimum Age:	18

SAFTY BOAT COURSE: €260, + €60 residential in dorms

(2 day course + 2 nights B&B, 2 lunch, 1 dinner)

Safety Boat Course - Those who have filled up the log book from gained at the previous certification are eligible for this course. ISA description: The "driving licence" of powerboating. This course provides all of the skills and knowledge required by anyone taking charge of a powerboat.



Course Type:	Personal Level
Craft Type:	Powerboat
Course Skill:	Advanced
Assumed Knowledge:	ISA National Powerboat Certificate or an equivalent. It is strongly recommended that participants hold a first aid certificate and the Short Range (SRC) VHF radio operator's certificate.
Description:	Primarily aimed at instructors and racing clubs this course prepares you to escort and provide safety / rescue cover for fleets of dinghies, windsurfers and canoes taking part in training or racing activities and to assist in race management duties
Content:	Boat preparation, boat handling, race Management, rescue of sailing dinghies, Windsurfers, canoes, kayaks and Kitesurfers, towing, incident management & medical emergencies.
Ability After Course:	You will be able to escort and provide safety / rescue cover for a range of water sports activities including training and racing. You will be able to assist in race management duties.
Duration:	2 Days
Minimum Age:	18
